SCHOOL SCHEDULE

- FALL Semester will run from Wednesday, September 6th, 2023 through Saturday, January 27th, 2024.
- SPRING Semester will run from Monday, January 29th through June 9, , 2024. The Spring Performance is scheduled
 for the weekend of June 8 & 9, 2024 at the Ridgefield High School.
- The Ridgefield School of Dance follows the Ridgefield Public School schedule in the event of inclement weather not school days off and reserves the option to have in-studio or zoom classes based on actual weather conditions. Notification will be sent via text message.

IMPORTANT SCHOOL POLICIES:

- PARENTS of PreBallet through Ballet 2 dancers are welcome to observe class. Parents of Ballet 3 through Company
 may observe classes the last week of each month.
- THE SCHOOL RESERVES the right to cancel a class due to insufficient enrollment and to close a class when it has
 reached capacity.
- DANCERS SHOULD ARRIVE at the studio with enough time to dress and be ready to start on time. DANCERS LATE TO CLASS may enter the studio at any time. Dancers Ballet 3 and up may participate in class if they arrive within 15 minutes of the start of class and with permission of the instructor. Dancers arriving later than 15 minutes may be asked to observe class. MOBILE devices are not allowed in the studio during class except when recording choreography.
- CLASSES MISSED due to illness or other conflicts may be made-up by taking another scheduled class on the same
 or lower level within the same term they were missed. Students are welcome to make-up classes in another discipline.
 There will be no refund or credit for missed classes.
- WITHDRAWALS There are no refunds for voluntary withdrawal from classes after the 2nd week of each session
 unless it is for a medical reason with a doctor's note.
- PERMISSION is granted to The Ridgefield School of Dance to use and publish for editorial, trade, advertising or
 other promotional purpose all photographic, video, and digital images of your child, in conjunction with the studio
 and school name. Parents who do not wish their child's image to be used in this manner must declare so in writing.
- A LIABILITY WAIVER must be signed through the parent portal, or on hard copy, prior to the first class.
- MEDICAL INSURANCE: The Ridgefield School of Dance does not carry medical insurance for its students. It is
 required that all dance students be covered by their own family insurance and if injury occurs it is understood that the
 family's medical policy is the only source of reimbursement.
- EMAIL & TEXTING: Please make sure we have your correct email address and cel phone number and subscribe to texting on our parent portal as we send out information about classes, class cancellations, rehearsal and performance schedules via email and/or text. Your email address will be used exclusively for The Ridgefield School of Dance purposes. Please include alison@theridgefieldschoolofdance.com, and alison@ridgefield.dance in your address book.Check spam/junk/marketing folders in case emails are accidentally re-routed. It is important to subscribe to texting on our parent portal.
- CLOSURE for COVID-19: Should in-studio classes be suspended due to COVID-19 related reasons, classes will
 immediately continue on Zoom on a regular schedule although some classes may be combined.

REGISTRATION & TUITION POLICIES:

To register your dancer and insure her/his place in class, please remit the following:

- 1. A signed tuition form or all information requested through our parent portal.
- 2. There is a non-refundable annual registration fee of \$75.
- 3. Tuition must be must be paid in full before the student may take class unless a payment plan is arranged and a credit card on file. Registration fees and \$75.00 of the tuition are non-refundable.
- 4. Payment may be made via Zelle: 914.414.3797, Check, Cash, Venmo @Alison-Brown-64, or credit card. There is a 2% convenience fee for credit card charges.
- 5. A deposit for costumes is charged in the Fall and applied to the purchase of costumes for the SPRING performance. Costumes, including shipping and sales tax often exceed the deposit. If costumes cost more than the deposit, your account will be charged the difference. If your dancer does not continue in the Spring session, costume fees will be refunded. The purchase of tickets for the performances

- finance the expenses incurred for performances. Tickets are available for purchase 3 to 4 weeks before the performance.
- There are absolutely NO REFUNDS for voluntary withdrawal from classes after the 2nd week unless it is for a medical reason with a doctor's note.
- 7. A discount will be given to families with more than one student dancing.
- 8. <u>Discounts</u> are void on past due balances <u>unless</u> a payment plan and credit card is in place.

DRESS CODE:

HAIR: To limit distractions dancer's hair should be neatly secured away from their face. Short hair should be held back in a headband and barrettes.

Pre-Ballet, Ballet 1: hair up and off the face in a bun or a tidy pony tail.

Ballet 2 through Company: tidy bun.

Jazz Department dancers: high pony tail.

NO JEWELRY (including braided wrist and ankle bands, watches or rings) may be worn in class.

FOOD - No food of any sort is allowed in the dance studios.

DANCE ATTIRE - Dance attire may be purchased at Joy of Movement located at 17 Danbury Road, Girolmetti Court in Ridgefield. 203.438.4555. We recommend that ballet slippers be properly fitted at a store for dance attire. We recommend Freed pointe shoes which are available at Attitudes in Norwalk.

Girls: Leotard colors with light pink tights with feet and pink ballet slippers.

Pre-Professional Division - Black leo of choice or black Bloch Adults Essential camisole leotard or comparable *ballet skirt optional but must be removable and best used when leaving the studio

Ballet Slippers: Pink Ballet slippers.

Ballet 4 & up - LEATHER BALLET SLIPPERS (may be split sole)

Pointe shoes must have elastic and ribbons sewn on. Miss Jess recommends Classic or Studio Freeds available at Attitude 181 Westport Avenue, Norwalk CT 06851.

Please speak with an instructor for guidance before sewing on elastic and ribbons.

Tights: All female ballet dancers wear pink tights during class.

- · For Performances:
- Ballet 3 through Pre-Professional division must wear Bodywrappers convertible tights in Ballet Pink Item # C45 (child) #A45 (adult).

Boys: White or Black T-shirts, black footless tights, white socks, black ballet slippers.

DANCE ATTIRE FOR JAZZ/LYRICAL/CONTEMPORARY/MTD DANCE STUDENTS:

Leotard: Black leotard and jazz shorts. If coming from or going into ballet class, ballet class leotard is acceptable Tights: stirrup or footless tights optional for class.

Shoes: Lyrical/Contemporary: Bare feet, toe undies or pirouette slippers. Hair in a bun or high ponytail.

Jazz students: Tan or beige jazz shoes (no black), possible need for character shoes

Hair pulled back off face in a high ponytail.

No jewelry. No T-shirts or loose tops

Boys: Shorts and T-shirt

DANCE ATTIRE FOR TAP: Girls: Black Leotard, tights and/or fitted jazz shorts. Black, lace-up, hard-or medium-hard sole tap shoes. Boys: hard or medium-hard sole lace-up tap shoes.

FOR PERFORMANCES: All female jazz department (including Contemporary, Lyrical, Theatre Dance, and Tap) dancers must wear Bodywrappers stirrup tights # C32 (child) or #A 32 (Adult) in Jazzy Tan, and the appropriate shoes for class.
